## Game Day Expectations

### Game Day Dress –

#### During the school day-

**JV/Freshmen** will need to wear slacks/khaki pants, button down (Blue/Black/or White) dress shirt, and a tie on their respective game day (typically Thursday). If they do not wear the proper attire, there is a possibility they might not be allowed to participate in the contest that day. If any athlete needs help in this area, they must communicate a few days in advance so our coaching staff or booster club can have an opportunity to go get the student/athlete game day clothing.

**Varsity** will need to wear slacks/khaki pants, button down (Blue/Black/or White) dress shirt, and a tie on their respective game day (typically Friday). If they do not wear the proper attire, there is a possibility they might not be allowed to participate in the contest that day. If any athlete needs help in this area, they must communicate a few days in advance so our coaching staff or booster club can have an opportunity to go get the student/athlete game day clothing.

#### During the Contest -

**Varsity/JV/Freshmen** – Athletes will only be allowed to wear accessories that are our school colors. Whether it be tights, sleeves, head covers, etc., they must be solid Royal Blue, Black or White. There will be no exceptions to this rule. We want our teammates to all look alike as to represent the team and not individualism.

### Team Meals and Game Day Food-

On occasion Food will be provided for the various teams. Except when we have food donated or when booster club provides food, there will be a \$5 charge for meals. If there is a charge for food, athletes will be expected to provide the money or have communicated in advance that they may have a need due to financial constraints.

### Game Day Transportation –

Athletes will be expected to ride the bus to the event and also ride the bus back from the event unless absolutely necessary that they arrange something different in advance. Athletes will only be allowed to be transported by their parents and or legal guardians and must have a signed note in advance. This exception is for rare occasions and emergency situations.
